Programme Structure:

The Foundation degree is designed to offer a full time award over two academic years with the accumulation of 240 credits, 120 at level 1 and 120 at level 2. The integration of academic and workplace learning is a strong feature of the Foundation degree programme supporting practitioners to use their workplace as the focus for their learning, with time spent in both practice and academia.
